Individuals possessing a Ph.D., with two or more years of postdoctoral experience and a strong publication record, are encouraged to apply. Applicants should demonstrate excellence in research and a strong potential for securing and sustaining independent and collaborative external funding. A successful applicant will be expected to develop an innovative, independent research program, and to share our commitment to excellence in undergraduate and graduate education.

Applications should include

- 1) Cover letter
- 2) Curriculum Vitae (with a full list of publications including impact factors and citations)
- 3) Research statement (should not exceed three pages and should include past research accomplishments, current projects and future research plans).
- 4) Teaching statement
- 5) Three letters of recommendation (letters from Ph.D. and Post-doctoral mentors are mandatory) and should be sent directly by referees.
